RECTANGULAR YELLOW STONE

Description: A rectangular mixed cut light yellow faceted transparent stone in a gold ring

Dimensions: 15.27 x 9.36 x 9.48 mm

Gemmological Features: A doubly refractive uniaxial material with R.I. of 1.761 – 1.770 showing a subdued apricot reaction under LWUV.

Scattered crystals, altered silk and a minor liquid feather were noted under magnification.
